I will be demonstrating (and requesting critique) of a technique we used to map and compare density and distribution changes in two shrimp populations in Yaquina Bay, OR. This technique uses randomization (done in R) to determine if the amount and direction of change is more than would be expected by random chance. Hopefully this presentation will be an interesting exploration of a statistical technique that goes beyond the quantification techniques normally used in GIS.
